



Request For Proposals (RFP)

1 Storey House and Garage 507 Main St., Montague, PE. Located on PID #198978

The Department of Transportation & Infrastructure, Properties Section, is requesting Proposals for the restoration of the above noted site to its pre-developed condition. Proposals are to be submitted on or before 2:00 pm., Thursday, Oct. 19, 2023, which shall include and be the responsibility of the proponent:

- Obtaining all required permit(s).
- **Maintaining general liability insurance** of not less than Two Million (\$2,000,000.00) Dollars.
- Remove or Demolish the 1 Storey House and Garage and remove all Debris to an approved disposal site as per the Department of Environment, Energy & Climate Action "Guidelines for Disposal of Demolition Debris" and in compliance with all Federal, Provincial and Municipal Statutes.

Note: In the event of DEMOLITION, a salvage operation may be undertaken by Habitat for Humanity prior to Demolition.

- Contaminants and Hazardous Material: The proponent shall be responsible for the identification of, and lawful removal to *Environmental Protection Act* standards from the site of any and all household contaminants and/or hazardous materials excluding existing contaminated soils. Coordination of said removal with all appropriate authorities.
- Utilities connected to the site must be disconnected by the respective utility company to their own satisfaction.
- Foundation(s) including concrete walls, floors, footings, concrete slab, posts, etc, with all concrete material being removed in their entirety from the site. All excavated areas, including within the foundation(s) walls and immediately outside as required to accomplish removal/demolition, septic pits and areas, must be filled with common borrow, levelled and rough graded.
- **Septic System(s)** shall be decommissioned as per all Federal, Provincial & Municipal Statutes and Regulations and excavations restored as per remedial action below (no concrete is to remain on site tanks must be removed).
- Wells shall be abandoned in compliance with *Environmental Protection Act* water well regulations.
- **Extraneous Debris:** All extraneous debris on site shall be removed and disposed of in accordance with all Federal, Provincial and Municipal Statutes and Regulations.

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- **Remedial Action**: All excavated areas including within the foundation(s) walls and immediately outside as required to accomplish removal/demolition, septic pits and areas, must be filled with common borrow, levelled and rough graded.
- All structures located on the subject property are to be removed and all site restoration work is to be completed within 30 days of the execution of the Removal/Demolition Agreement.
- Any successful proponent will be required to enter into a formal Removal/Demolition Agreement with the Department of Transportation & Infrastructure and submit a performance deposit in the amount of \$2,500.00 dollars (only if purchasing the structure to be moved), which is refundable upon compliance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Increased security measures have been implemented at the Jones Building. Visitors must present valid identification and receive a visitor's pass at the main door upon arrival. All bidders are responsible to account for any additional time required to gain access to the third floor. Late bids shall not be received under any circumstances.

NOTE:

- HST will be added to bid price.
- All tenders to purchase must be accompanied by a deposit of 15% in the form of a certified cheque/bank draft or money order payable to the <u>Minister of Finance</u> (only if paying to purchasing the structure).
- The subject 1 Storey House and Garage will be sold on an "AS IS" basis with no disclosure statement
