### **Active Transportation**

The Town of Stratford has substantially completed the initiatives laid out in its fifteen-year Active Transportation Plan and is now in the process of developing a new plan. We are interested in learning more about Stratford residents' preference for sidewalks or multi-use paths within subdivisions where a determination has been made that an Active Transportation path is required.

"Active Transportation" refers to any form of human-powered transportation – walking, cycling, wheelchair, inline skating or skateboarding.

"Sidewalk" refers to a 5-foot-wide concrete path between the curb/lateral lines of the road, street, lane, drive, or avenue and the adjacent property lines intended for the use of pedestrians.
